'Tax Competition, Common Consolidated Corporate Tax Base and Fiscal Autonomy'

Call for Papers

On July 9-10, 2012, the Scottish Institute for Research in Economics jointly with the University of Glasgow and the University of Strathclyde will organise a Conference on International Business Taxation, which will take place in Glasgow, Scotland.

The programme, organised by Celine Azemar (University of Glasgow), Rodolphe Desbordes (University of Strathclyde) and Ronald B. Davies (University College Dublin) consists on the presentation of academic papers with half a day devoted to discussion with policy makers and practitioners.

The purpose of this conference is to address issues related to tax competition, a common consolidated corporate tax base, and fiscal autonomy. Empirically oriented research and applied theoretical research are welcome. Preference will be given to papers by PhD students and young authors. Papers will be selected on the basis of completed papers. The deadline for submission is May 15, 2012. Authors chosen to present papers will be notified by May 25, 2012. Travel and accommodation expenses for participants will be covered.
